Minutes: Minutes were reviewed, one correction on the number of schedules to print noted, and motion was made to approve April Minutes, seconded, and all were in favor.

Financial Report: Current Intergroup Checking Balance \$6762.19 minus \$930 Prudent Reserve = **\$5832.19 available balance.**

Motion was made to approve Financial Report, seconded, and all were in favor.

Reports:

PI/CPC: Chair Will D. presented AA developed public information/professional community cards that are available to download and print from the Area 16 AA website. Will D. was able to add a QR code for a link to the District 3 Intergroup website as well as the Intergroup phone number. These would be made available to hand out at events and within professional communities. A motion was made to pay for 2000 cards for distribution with 1000 for public information and 1000 for the professional communities at a cost of \$277.08. The motion was seconded and all were in favor.

Telephone: The Darien group will maintain the phone for the month of May, Happy Hour for June, and First Things First for July. A motion to renew was made, seconded, and all were in favor.

OLD Business:

By-laws have been updated, and the motions were made to approve them final; seconded, all were in favor.

Corporation Status of Intergroup: IRS was contacted and still waiting for a response.

Founders' Day Picnic: 120 additional chairs are needed at the picnic site. It was discussed to increase the picnic budget with an additional \$400.00 to pay for the chairs and their delivery and pick up, while including a \$100.00 buffer for any last-minute needs. A motion was made to increase the budget by \$400.00. It was seconded and all were in favor.

Motion was made to accept Old Business; seconded, all were in favor.

Alternates for all IG positions: All IG members were reminded to seek home group members who would like to join in service work by becoming alternate chair holders.

NEW BUSINESS:

Election dates for future new officers were discussed. A motion was made that elections will take place each January with the IG Chairperson and Treasurer positions alternate year. It was seconded and all were in favor.

Newsletter: Dawn R. will be creating a quarterly digital Intergroup Newsletter. She will be reaching out to AA Members and Intergroup members for newsletter input. A QR code will be provided to our District to download and read.
